

Language knowledge in general

If you are applying for the **MBA-IMC® (start in the summer term)** course you should if possible have already attained the necessary knowledge of the German/ English language in your home country. Proof of your ability level is very important. Ideally you will have passed a DSH examination (minor or major German language diploma from the Goethe Institute) or the Testdaf examination.

Confirmation of the number of lessons taken is unfortunately not sufficient. As proof of proficiency in English you should for example be able to show TOEFEL with 550 points paper-based or 213 points computer-based. If you have evidence of completing your first course of study in English or German or of spending longer periods of time in an appropriate country you can present this as a confirmation of adequate linguistic ability.

Applicants for the **MBA-ILMC® and MBA-IMC® (start in the winter term)** course on the other hand only need a basic knowledge of German as the teaching language is English. If you want to work during the course, you need sufficient German language skills!
